CREATE YOUR OWN MANHATTAN TRAVEL GUIDE

SUBWAYS AND BUSES

A prepaid MetroCard is needed for subways and buses. MetroCards are available for sale in subway stations, but are not available for sale on buses. Merchants displaying MetroCard signs in their windows (newsstands, grocery stores, etc.) sell select types of MetroCards. Rides are \$2.25 each way.
